

# YEA 2010 young european actuaries

## International seminar for Young European Actuaries (YEA)

### Introduction

After one year of (involuntary) absence due to the economic turmoil, the international YEA seminar will be back in 2010. The fourth edition of the seminar will be held from 16 to 18 September 2010 in Zürich, Switzerland.

The YEA seminar is a three day event for young (future) actuaries from all over Europe up to the age of 35. The seminar offers young actuaries the opportunity to network, to exchange experiences with fellow actuaries from their own country and other countries, and to extend their knowledge of the discipline. Previous seminars were held in Aix-la-Chapelle (Aachen, 2006), Luxembourg (2007) and Brussels (2008). In these editions, actuaries from the Netherlands, Belgium, Germany, Portugal, Luxembourg, France, Austria and Switzerland took part. In 2010, we hope to welcome about 100 participants from even more European countries.



### Organisation team

The YEA seminar is organised by an enthusiastic team of young actuaries from most of the countries that participate in the seminar. In 2009, YEA joined the Groupe Consultatif Actuariel Européen, which represents 35 actuarial associations throughout Europe. Apart from offering support, the Groupe Consultatif also guarantees the event. The organisation team of the seminar is also supported by the professional associations of actuaries from the various countries.



### Program

Like the previous years, an attractive program will be offered, in which the acquisition and sharing of knowledge will be interspersed with social activities. To stimulate the interaction between the actuaries, the organisation team will prepare a number of assignments of which the participants (divided in sub-groups) are supposed to solve one during the seminar. While solving an assignment, participants share their knowledge and work on their personal development. During the seminar, professionals from several disciplines will be present to provide help and information about the case.

The assignments will deal with issues in the fields of pensions or (life/non-life) insurance and will be chosen with care to ensure that they are consistent as far as possible with the permanent education requirements applicable to actuaries in various countries.
